I took Jer 29:11 seriously & filled in my teaching form to be sent anywhere!!! And so the adventure with God began.....However, the greatest gift he has given me is an intimate & awesome & alive relationship with Jesus by the Spirit. Like Aretha Franklin sang, "Do you know Him?" Yes!! And He knows me!
