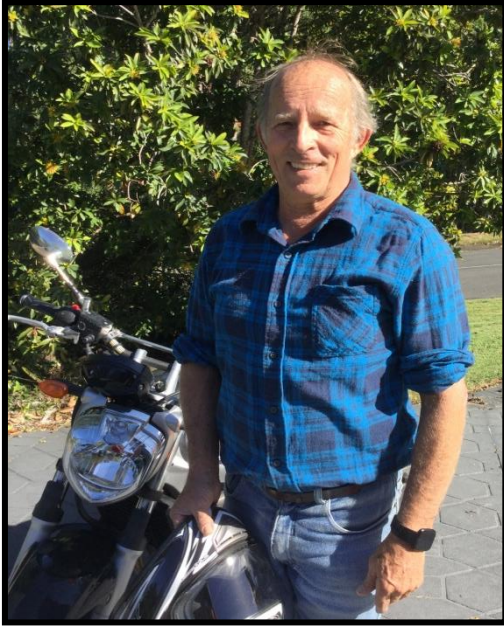


Phil Kronk – President Carpenter’s Workshop
