
Last Sunday our Stocktake focus was *Pastoral Care*. I highlighted the importance of being a church of generosity and hospitality (based on the Good Samaritan Parable) and for us to build each other up (Romans 15:2) by not Gossiping and upholding Confidentiality.



I asked everyone to ask the following questions about their conversations with each other:

- Are you speaking without the permission from the other person? Because it is their information to tell not ours.
- Is what you're saying rumours or untruths? Have you heard it from the person themselves?
- Are you sharing out of your own fears or insecurities? Why are you talking about this person or sharing information about this person?
- Are you tearing another person down by what you're saying?
- Is this causing division?
- Are you creating distrust within the church?

If you answer 'yes' to any of these questions then STOP. Or if you hear others talking like this then interrupt the conversation and say something similar to any of the following:

"This person is not here so we need to stop this conversation now."

"I don't think this conversation is helpful - let's change topic."

"Remember what Catherine said, I think this is gossip; we need to stop this conversation."

Thank you for those who are already changing patterns of conversations. It's making a huge impact towards building a stronger, more trusting and loving community.

Pastoral Care is at the heart of the witness of being a caring community with Christ.

This week our stocktake focus is *Families*. Currently our Elanora Congregation doesn't have a lot to offer for young families or youth. The Church Council has some very exciting news to share with you on Sunday about the possibility of growing our Family Ministry in an intentional and practical way.

So keep collecting your stocktake cards and checking where you are at personally, ready for August 18 – Stocktake Reconciliation Sunday.




