

SUNDAY'S READINGS:
Haggai 2:1-9
Luke 20:27-38

Today we continue reading from Luke; however we also add a passage from the Book of Haggai. Have you ever read it? It's one of the smallest books in the Bible consisting of only 2 chapters and forms part of what's called *the Minor Prophets*.

The Major Prophets include Isaiah and Jeremiah, so from Ezekiel through to the New Testament we find *the Minor Prophets* writings. Haggai is set around the time of 520BC. He writes to stir the Jewish people into rebuilding the temple in Jerusalem after its destruction by Nebuchadnezzar about 60 years earlier.

I encourage you if you are able to read through the 2 chapters before worship on Sunday, as this will no doubt enrich your understanding of the sermon. May you 'give careful thought' as you read!

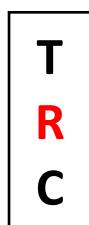
