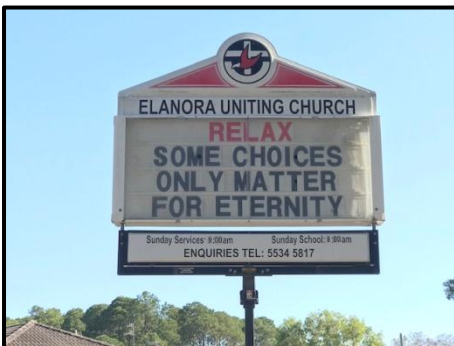
PEOPLE IN NEED

SOUTH MORETON PRESBYTERY MEETING UPDATE

held Saturday 9th November at

Beenleigh Uniting Church

Reps: Rev Catherine Solomon & Mr Mervyn Head

- Mrs Susan Hawke was commissioned in the new Presbytery position of Community Development Officer for Flagstone (emerging housing development near Beaudesert) for three years.
- Proposal accepted by consensus – to close Twin Towns UC and establish on that site Newlife Coolangatta as a faith community, led by Scott Wrigley from 2 February, 2020.
- Proposal accepted by consensus – to amalgamate the Congregations of Yeronga, Wellers Hill & Tarragindi, St Mark's Mt Gravatt and Holland Park to form a new Congregation from 1 January 2020.
- The Presbytery reaffirmed the call of David Busch to the position of Presbytery Minister, South Moreton Presbytery as an ordained minister, with his ordination and induction to be held in conjunction with the February 2020 Presbytery meeting.
- Rev Janie French concluded her placement at Banora Point and has commenced at St David's Coopers Plains (Brisbane).
- Rev Karen Ross has been ordained and inducted as minister for Beenleigh Region UC.
- There are currently 11 people actively undergoing a Period of Discernment process seeking clarity on God's call for their life.
- There are currently 11 placements in our Presbytery with supply ministers/pastors (Capalaba, Pimpama, Tallebudgera, Holland Park, Southport, Twin Towns, Victoria Point, Burleigh Heads, Banora Point, Ashmore, Logan Central Multicultural)
