These are some of the responses offered over Morning Tea (via zoom).

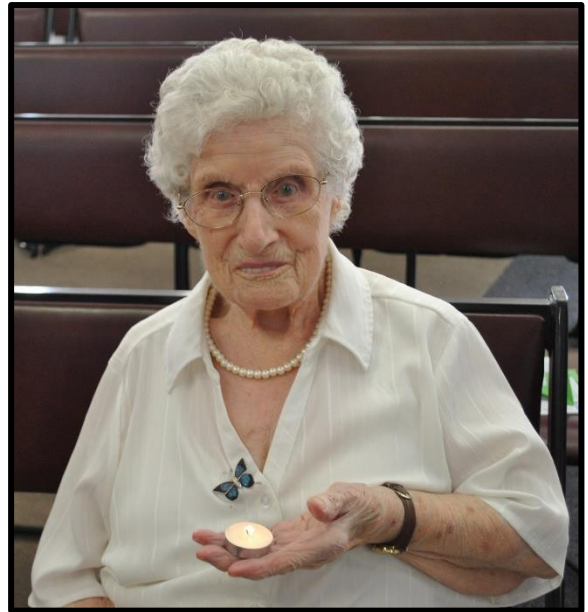
- + The need for patience and prayer;

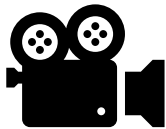
## WORSHIP ONLINE

Consequently we need to continue the practice of putting our services on-line. Each week Catherine and myself have been producing the complete pre-recorded worship services with our personal camera equipment. This equipment however, is unsuitable for recording and livestreaming an entire one hour service.

We are therefore seeking a digital camcorder to be loaned temporarily or given permanently to be fixed at the rear of the church and connected directly into the A/V computer. I am trying to configure a robust and simple system that just needs a button press to operate each Sunday. Future services will be then able to be live streamed on-line as well as being able to output to DVD or USB thumb-drives for anyone unable to view the service on Facebook or YouTube.
