***SAFE WATER FOR REMOTE COMMUNITIES (PNG) – Unitingworld has been working with the United Church in PNG since 2015 helping more than 5822 people in three Milne Bay communities to improve water supply and hygiene behaviour. The aim is to alleviate poverty.**
***INVESTING IN THE SKILLS OF WEST PAPUAN WOMEN – on a small island in a lake a group of women are crafting themselves out of poverty and keeping a local tradition alive: they make canvases out of beaten bark and paint them with traditional designs.**
