A little bit about me - I was born in Coburg Victoria. I have two brothers and we were brought up in the Presbyterian Church by wonderful parents. Sadly, my Dad passed away when I was 17 and my brothers were 14 and 11. My Mother was an amazing loving Christian who had a wonderful influence on us.

At 21 I married my husband Eric who was an Irish Catholic and a Vietnam Veteran - we were blessed with three children - Melanie, Melinda, and Liam. Eric worked as a linesman with the SEC Victoria and we moved several times to the country but wherever we lived the Uniting Church was always a big part of my life and I taught Sunday School, RE in primary school as well as becoming an elder in the Church. In 1992 we moved to Labrador in Queensland where I attended the UC and then the Southport UC where I also taught Sunday School, RE at Southport SS, became an elder and began a Kids Hope program at the Southport SS. Five years ago Eric and I moved to Galleon Gardens as he was diagnosed with lung cancer. He passed away four years ago.

I feel very blessed to be a member of the Elanora UC where I have become a Kids Hope Mentor and where I have found a wonderful outreach at Coinda. Coinda is a meeting place where it is possible to share God's love with everyone who enters - especially the elderly who live at Pineshaven and Elanora Gardens. My hope for Coinda is that we can reach out to more people and maybe some young mothers in need of meeting others who may be in need of some companionship as well as a great coffee!
