

# A message from Teagan Craig Service Leader at Gold Coast Homeless Hub

I have spoken with our Cook and he has identified some cupboard items (home brand is fine!) that would assist in his provision of 300+ meals per week from our Homeless Hub.

- Baked Beans
- Fettuccini
- Rice
- Coffee
- Sugar
- Powdered Milk
- Plastic forks, knives, spoons, plates, bowls (we are currently offering take away meals outside due to COVID)
- 24pk 600ml waters (also needing to provide with meals due to COVID and no access to water fountain inside)
- Washing powder
- Napkins
- Tissues

These items would help us continue to support the homeless community with our hot breakfast and lunch which is part of our drop-in service every Monday through Friday. It would also support the provision of 3 meals a day every day for the 6 residents of our on-site men's crisis accommodation. Hygiene items are also provided to individuals who are sleeping rough and access our service for showers (we also provide towels and launder them- hence the washing powder).

## At the moment regarding hygiene items:

- Deodorant (roll on only)
- Soap bars or small body wash
- Razors



We deliver donations of nonperishable food and other items to Blair Athol as an outreach activity. Please leave items in the baskets in the church or at the church office.
