Thank you to the generous donors providing the opportunity for the church to purchase a new computer, a splitter box and new camera (\$3189 – leaving us with money left over to set up the internet reliably into the church once NBN is connected). Currently we are using mobile data.

This process has required a lot of thinking, researching, testing, conversing with others and setting up. Thank you to Andrew Solomon for all the behind the scenes energy and expertise that has gone into this initiative. He has sacrificed many working hours to make this happen.



NO SOUND???? As we roll out the implementation of livestreaming there will be some teething problems. Last week, a number of people had issues with volume and sound. We are aware of the output volume being low and we are working on this solution with other churches who use the same product and are having similar issues.

Please note: sound was coming through but was very quiet.

If you had no sound at all, please check the volume control on your device (phone, computer, tablet) to make sure the volume is up and mute is switched off. YouTube also has a volume bar and a mute facility. Likewise, please check the YouTube volume is turned up and the mute is switched off. If you wear a hearing aid you might find it helpful as well.

This is a huge learning curve for the worship team. Let me reassure you we are working very hard to provide a meaningful worship experience for everyone outside the church building.
