
Welcome to Worship at Elanora Uniting Church 20 September 2020

Congregational Update - COVID 19



Message from Rev Catherine

Covid safety is important for everyone. We have a number of people who have offered their time and care in keeping us safe and organised as we come to onsite worship.

Please be aware of the following:

- a. Because of the importance of keeping our Covid safety industry plan, you will probably be sitting in a different position each week. Please help the ushers by listening to them as they find your seat. The usher role is not an easy one particularly as we get closer to the start of worship time. Please consider arriving early to help the team. This will also assist in reducing congestion at the entrance area.
- **b.** Please DO NOT lower or lift seats. The seating has been carefully considered to maintain 1.5m between households as well as managing our maximum capacity in the church of 50 people. When we reach 50, we open up into the hall.
- c. Keep 1.5 m distance to those around you (other than your household)
- **d.** PLEASE PRE-REGISTER FOR WORSHIP EVERY WEEK! Over the last few weeks our numbers of attendance have increased and our maximum is 85 people in the church and hall +6 for those involved with worship sitting on dais/periphery (sound, data, singers, musician, minister). Once we reach our 85, we will need to tap on the shoulder people who we know could participate online offsite. Please help the team by pre-registering in person on a previous Sunday, by email, or by phone to the office.
