

#### WELCOME TEAM SESSION UPDATE



#### From Rev Catherine Solomon

I want to take this opportunity to thank our welcome team for serving so carefully in welcoming everyone physically to worship with a completely new process under Covid-19 regulations.

The church council adopted an industry plan for worship to occur, and it is extremely important that we follow these guidelines. Did you know that if an inspector were to attend a worship service and found someone in breach of the plan, an individual may be given an on the spot fine of \$1334 and the church \$6670 fine under the Public Health Act 2005? This plan is put in place to keep people safe and reduce the risk of community transmission. Here is some helpful information for your awareness:

- 1. Please REGISTER for worship We can host 85 people seated in the church and hall. Please register your attendance (at the door or through the office) and arrive early to keep the movement at the entrance flowing.
- 2. Please keep 1.5m distance outside and inside the building. Please no hugging or touching.
- 3. Please help the ushers by listening to their instructions, and please be aware that you will not be sitting in the same seat each week.
- 4. Once you are seated, please remain in that seat till worship has ended. Please do not change seats or lift or put down any seats as any seats vacated would then need to be Covid cleaned before someone else sat down.

- 5. After the service is over please move outside promptly. People have volunteered their time to count the offering and to clean all the seats, door handles etc. These volunteers can't complete their roles while people remain in the building. Please take advantage of space outside to talk with others.
- 6. ASSISTANCE needed with moving chairs After worship, the chairs in the hall need to be packed away, after they've been cleaned. Can you help with moving chairs? Please see Norma Waller.

There is no expectation for anyone to be physically present at worship. If you are unable to receive worship online or physically come to worship, a printed copy of the sermon is available from the office during the week, 9-10:30am.

Where? At 16 Tatha Avenue, Palm Beach.


When? Each Monday from 12<sup>th</sup> October at 7 P.M.

#### **CHURCH COUNCIL NEWS – Rhonda Coleman**

- Church council is working on a draft strategic plan to bring to the congregation
- The Congregation Annual meeting was due on the last Sunday in March, but COVID had other ideas. it has been rescheduled to 18th November. The good news is we already have all the reports done.
- The main prayer point is the two vacant positions. If you or someone you
  think is being led to be on church council please talk to Rev
  Catherine. Nomination forms will be out in late October for voting at the
  meeting.
- Dwell has started and some other groups are looking at recommencing, so
  please try to keep halls uncluttered so we present a good face to our
  community.
- The Christmas mural on the cupboards in the hall is looking tired, so we have photographed it for the record and a local artist is going to work with the Dwell youth to paint a new uplifting mural there.
- Pam Ganderton has taken on some of the financial responsibilities until we can find a treasurer, while Mervyn is still helping us out by keeping the MYOB computer documentation and reporting going for the moment.
- Our incoming finances are down \$12,000 in the first eight months of this
  year from what was budgeted; however, our expenses are also down
  meaning we are managing at the moment. We have been advised that it is
  unlikely we will continue to receive job keeper for our minister after
  September.
- COVID updates are communicated to church council each week and we
  would like to thank everyone for taking this seriously. This is helping us to
  gradually recommence our activities on site.
- If you access the church during the week, remember to clean everything
  you touched. We also ask that people do not congregate in the building
  after the service as the cleaners need to have the space cleared so they can
  clean immediately after the service.
