
Sunday Funday

Prayers and support for the Presbyterian Church of Queensland: A response from our Presbytery.

The Presbyterian Church of Queensland has recently been placed in receivership and is seeking a sustainable way forward. Our Presbytery Minister, Rev David Busch, wrote the following to the PCQ Moderator, Rev. Dr Phil Strong, and Clerk, Mr Stuart Hoadley, assuring them that "we are sisters and brothers in Christ with a cherished shared history and a common ongoing mission in Christ" and that "we acknowledge your pain and uncertainty...We recognize the responsibilities upon you both as leaders, holding your people in the confidence of God's faithfulness and purposes while also dealing with complex institutional and financial matters and, most likely, very difficult decisions. May you know the guidance and empowerment of God and be able to rest in His grace as you carry those responsibilities forward. With you, we look with expectancy and hope for God's new life to emerge for the PCQ through this unsettling period, perhaps in unexpected ways. Meanwhile, if there is any way that our churches and people might support the Presbyterian Church locally or more widely, please don't hesitate to ask."

The Clerk has replied with gratitude: "It is deeply encouraging to know that you and our brothers and sisters in Christ in the Uniting Church are upholding us and standing with the Presbyterian Church of Qld through this difficult time. The compassionate words and offer of support from the UC Presbytery of South Moreton are very much appreciated. At this time, it is not clear how matters will unfold. But we know with confidence that our Heavenly Father is in control and that he will use this to shape his Church. We cling to the promises in Christ and keep focussed on gospel service and proclamation."

With our shared heritage let us be united in prayer and offer support in any way the Spirit leads us.
