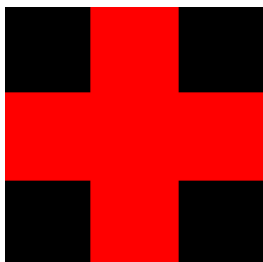

CPR and First Aid Training

Saturday, May 28 at Living Faith, Carina Heights, AND

Saturday, June 4 at Burleigh Heads Uniting Church

2 sessions

CPR training-9.30am to 12pm (9.15am arrival)

First Aid training-12.45pm to 3.30pm (afternoon tea provided)

The First Aid course includes the CPR training in the morning. Hence, this is a full day course.

Costs: CPR training -\$50
