INFORMATION FOR MARKET DAY STALL HOLDERS

- ✓ If you wish to book a table to sell your goods, please inform Barrie or another person at the front desk.
- ✓ Tables are \$8 or \$4 for ½ table.
- ✓ Only Leisuretime and Carpenter's Workshop Members are eligible to sell goods.
- ✓ Goods sold must have been made by the stall holders
- ✓ Proceeds from the sale of goods are kept by the stall holder.
- ✓ Stall holders will be able to set up their tables from 7 am.



OTHER MARKET DAY INFORMATION:

- ✓ Leisuretime will advertise this event through the distribution of brochures, through Facebook, through the Church Newsletters and by Leisuretimers spreading the news 'through word of mouth'.
- ✓ Our \$6 entry fee will be paid, not on entry, but in class this is because visitors are not expected to pay to come to our stalls.
