Course

Accidental Counsellor is emotional awareness training designed to provide participants with the basic knowledge and skills to support someone who is experiencing an emotional crisis. The session will also highlight the importance of self-care and taking responsibility for your own emotional wellbeing.

Qualified, experienced Lifeline trainers deliver the training, and participants will receive a Statement of Attendance upon completion of this course.

Please note: The Accidental Counsellor course does not qualify you to be a counsellor or provide ongoing support. Participants will not receive any counselling qualification at the end of this training.
